## Making a block of ice

## A. <u>Day 1-</u>

- 1. Place a plastic liner inside the well.
- 2. Place the clips in the center of the short sides.

The clips will hold the plastic in place.

- 3. Fill the well with water to about 2" from the top.
- 4. Place 2 pumps in each well & plug in.
  - a. Place them in opposite corners.
  - b. 2 Pumps on day 1 make a clearer block.
  - c. Angle the pumps so they point down to the center of the block.

## B. <u>Day 2-</u>

- 1. Remove 1of the pumps.
- 2. Tilt the remaining pump up, so it shoots the water across the top of the block.

## C. Once the block reaches desired thickness-

- 1. Remove the pump.
- 2. Suck the remaining water out.
- 3. Clip the lifter bar into the lifter plates.
- 4. Using the hoist lift the block from it's well.
- 5. Place the block on a tilt cart.
- 6. Remove the lifter clips with a 6 prong pick.
- 7. Tilt upright.
- 8. Dolly the block into the freezer.

Fun fact- In 1920 750,000 blocks of ice were made in the US every day!
